

AFFIDAVIT
SUBMITTED FOR PROBABLE CAUSE DETERMINATION

Before me, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the affiant whose signature appears below, a peace officer for the State of Texas, who being duly sworn upon oath deposes and says that said affiant has good reason to believe and does believe that the accused person Sarah Nicole Henderson, did on or about the 2nd day of November 2017, commit the offense of Capital Murder which offense is charged to be classified as a () MISDEMEANOR (X) FELONY and is against the laws of the STATE OF TEXAS.

The Good reason and belief of the affiant officer for this affidavit is based upon the following facts and circumstances: On Thursday November 2, 2017 at about 0225 hours the Henderson County Sheriff's Office received a 9-1-1 call from a male stating his wife shot the children. The call was initiated at 239 Forest Lane Road Mabank, Henderson County, Texas 75156. Upon arrival, Henderson County Deputies contacted Sarah Henderson and her husband Jacob Henderson and secured both in patrol vehicles. When deputies cleared the home, they located two deceased female children one seven (7) years old and one five (5) years old.

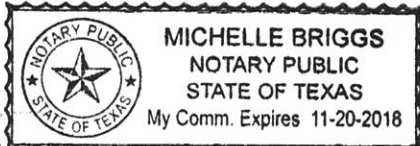
Sarah Henderson was placed under arrest and transported to the Henderson County Detention Center where your affiant escorted her to a criminal investigations office and read her Miranda Rights. Sarah Henderson advised she understood her rights and agreed to speak with affiant. When asked why Henderson County Deputies were summoned to her house she said because she shot her kids. Due to the fact that both children are under ten (10) years of age and that Sarah Henderson confessed after being read and understanding her Miranda Rights, probable cause exists to believe Sarah Henderson committed capital murder which is a violation of Texas Penal Code 19.03 and is a capital felony.
